Barry Buddon Beach Clean - 28th October 10am

By its nature as a bay, the beach between Monifieth and the point of Barry Buddon acts as a collection point for large quantities of flotsam and jetsam carried in from the North Sea, and washed down river from Dundee and the wider Tay estuary. The photograph below shows the results of just a couple of hours of work by volunteers at a beach clean earlier this year and gives an idea of the quantities of plastic and other rubbish on this beach. The volunteers were watched by a pair of dolphins which came close into the shore where everyone was working, and gave their seal of approval!
